- People must call Yellow Cab of Terre Haute and mention the program to get a free ride home.
- Cab rides are provided from a bar or restaurant to an individual's residence—not to other drinking locations.
- Due to the high number of ride requests on Halloween, rides cannot be guaranteed for everyone who calls; however, every attempt will be made to accommodate all requests. Drivers have the right to use their discretion when accepting fares.
