



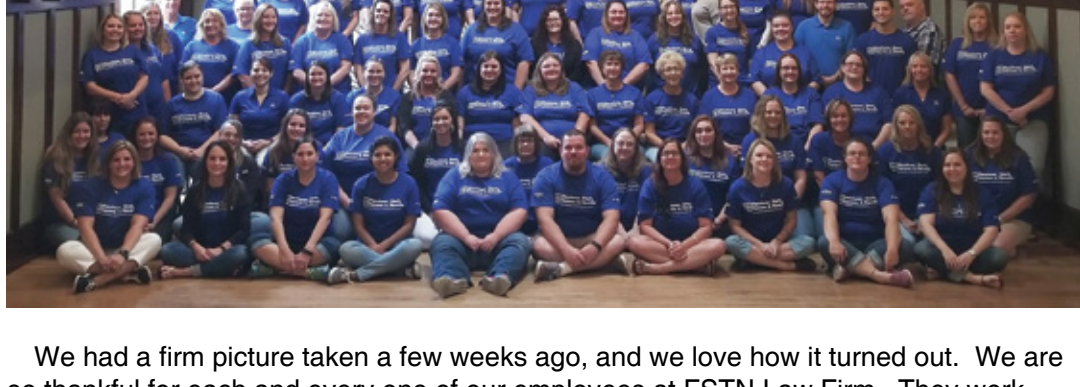

**FSTN Adopts a New Blessing Box at our Law Firm**



We recently installed a Blessing Box at Fleschner, Stark, Tanoos & Newlin Law Firm. We have one of the first locations for a Blessing Box in Terre Haute, IN, and we are the first business to adopt one. Up until now, it has been churches and missionaries to adopt and care for a Blessing Box.

If you have never heard of a Blessing Box, look up Blessing Boxes Brazil Indiana, to see what they are all about. It is basically a wooden, weather-proof, sealed box that is placed on a property and maintained by that organization or the public. At FSTN, we make sure the box has plenty of non-perishable food, toiletry items, personal hygiene items, diapers, etc. on a daily basis.

The box is open 24 hours a day and 7 days a week. Anyone can donate to the box, and anyone can take from the box. We only ask that the items are new/unopened items, including non-perishable food, toiletries, home supplies, etc.
